More to Life Mentoring Internet Program Privacy Policy

Kalani Sitake More to Life Foundation, Inc. (“More to Life”) takes your privacy seriously. This privacy policy covers the website CoachKalani.com (the “Site”) and is intended to help you understand our online information security practices. The policy covers More to Life’s treatment of personally identifiable information that it collects when you are visiting the Site and when you use More to Life’s referral services. We also ask that you review the Site’s Terms of Service.

This Privacy Policy is an integral part of the Site. If you do not agree to all of the terms of this Privacy Policy, you must not use the Site.

Also, please read our Childrens Privacy Policy to learn more about how we treat personally identifiable information collected from children.

Information Collection

The Site will not collect any personally identifiable information that is not voluntarily supplied by the user. The Site will not collect any personally identifiable information when you are browsing the Site. Certain actions on the Site require you to provide personal information such as your name, address, telephone number, email address, organizational information, and any other information that is necessary to complete that action, but no personally identifiable information will be obtained other than the information you enter. The actions that require your personal information include, but are not limited to, newsletter sign-ups, volunteer applications, requests for further information, donations, and True Blue Hero nominations. All of these actions are clearly marked and require a user to intentionally enter and provide personal information to the Site. The personal information you voluntarily provide to the Site will be used solely for the purposes set forth below.

Use of Personal Information.

1. Individual Volunteers. We use the information you voluntarily provide to help facilitate the volunteering process. Programs need this information to begin your application. Please be aware that, to the extent required to provide our services, we share your information with other volunteers or nonprofit organization partners. If you indicate on our site that you are interested in a particular mentoring opportunity and provide us with your contact information, we will forward your contact information to the organization that is hosting that opportunity so that the organization can contact you regarding your potential involvement.
2. Requested Services. The Site will use personal information to provide the services requested by you. For example, if you request that More to Life contact you, the Site will use your address or other personal information you entered to reply to your request.
3. Aggregate Information. We may share aggregate information about our users with certain third parties. This information shows user activity as a whole rather than on an

individual basis and cannot be used to individually identify you. We use this information to help our partners and funders better understand our services and also to report on public interest in mentoring.

Use of Cookies

“Cookies” are small files placed on your computer by our site that are used by your browser. The Site uses cookies to speed navigation, keep track of items, and provide you with custom-tailored content. We also use cookies to remember information you gave us so you don’t have to reenter it each time you visit our site. By showing us how and when visitors use our site, cookies also help us see which areas are popular and which are not. Many improvements and updates to our site are based on the data derived from these cookies, such as total number of visitors and pages viewed. Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies. If you wish, you can elect to set your browser to refuse cookies and will still be able to use most of the areas of our web site.

More to Life uses cookies for various reasons. We only read cookies written by our site and do not make information gathered by use of cookies available to any outside parties except in aggregate form (see Information Sharing and Disclosure below). We do not use cookies to obtain information on other web sites that you may visit. Cookies may be used to store some information about the parts of our site that you have visited previously. We do this to help you navigate our site more easily or to alert you to related pages on our site that may interest you.

Linking to Third Party Sites

When you click on links and/or ad banners that take you to third party web sites, you will be subject to the third parties’ privacy policies. While we support the protection of privacy on the Internet, this Privacy Policy applies only to this Site and More to Life cannot be responsible for the actions of third parties or the content on their web sites. We encourage you to read the posted privacy policy whenever interacting with any web site.

More to Life strongly encourages nonprofit organizations receiving e-mail addresses from potential volunteers to adopt privacy standards similar to those of More to Life. You should be aware that each such organization has its own policies regarding collection and use of personal information. More to Life is not responsible for their use of your personal information. Inappropriate use of personal information received from More to Life may jeopardize nonprofit listing on More to Life mentoring program database. More to Life reserves the right to determine, in its discretion, what constitutes inappropriate use of this information. Information from the nonprofit organizations is used by More to Life to consult with programs on ways to improve service.

Children’s Privacy
